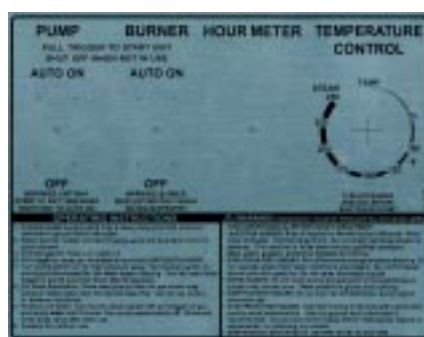
Fuel labels are made from lexan to prevent fuel spills and vapors from destroying them.

Hydro Man Tip:

We recommend replacing labels if they become damaged or illegible to meet safety requirements and prevent operator error. Follow the installation instructions or a problem will result with air bubbles and misalignment.

Installation Instructions:

1. For clear labels pre-mix water with 3 drops of liquid detergent in a spray bottle.
2. Clean smooth or stainless surfaces with alcohol or equivalent that evaporates quickly. Prepare powder coated surfaces with "Scotch Bright" abrasive pad or equivalent. Wipe with lint free cloth using alcohol or equivalent.
3. Spray surface and back of label with water solution. Labels applied to powder coated surfaces do not use water solution.
4. Place label and align.
5. Spray front of label with water solution and use a squeegee to smooth out bubbles and water, working from the center out.
6. Dab dry with towel and allow additional time to sit and dry.
